

Doctoral Program Prior Learning Assessment (PLA)

Steps to Request Doctoral PLA

- 1. Confirm that the course is included on the approved list for PLA (Appendix A)
- 2. Review course descriptions in the Academic Catalog and access the course learning outcomes
 - a. Request learning outcomes from the appropriate Doctoral Studies Director
 - i. Requests may be sent via your Admissions Specialist or Student Success Advisor
- 3. Complete Section A of the Doctoral Program PLA Request Form (see below)
- 4. Complete a Doctoral PLA Portfolio (recommended format is a PDF with a Table of Contents)
 - a. Component 1: Documentation that demonstrates proficiency of learning outcomes. Sample documents may include:
 - i. Resume or CV
 - ii. Job description
 - iii. Publications or work reports
 - iv. Supervisor letter of recommendation
 - b. Component 2: Essay describing achievement of each learning outcome
 - i. Address all learning outcomes individually
- 5. Submit the PLA Portfolio to the appropriate Doctoral Studies Director for assessment.

- 2. Assessment can take up to 10 business days
- 3. Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) credits are included in the calculation of maximum transfer credit eligibility. Refer to the <u>Policy Catalog</u> for more details on transfer credit limits.
